

Know Your Rights!

This is an excerpt from the Tennessee Stands Resolution that business closings, mask mandates and stay at home orders are in violation of the Tennessee Constitution. Section 8 is from the Tennessee Constitution and is in bold.

Tennessee Constitution

Section 8. "That no man shall be taken or imprisoned, or disseized of his freehold, liberties or privileges, or outlawed, or exiled, or in any manner destroyed or deprived of his life, liberty or property, but by the judgement of his peers, or the law of the land" and thereby as the law of the land can only be instituted by an action of the General Assembly per this constitution, we find all business closures, mask mandates and stay at home orders to be a direct violation of the Declaration of Rights of Article 1 of the Tennessee Constitution;

The Civil Rights Acts of 1964 is federal civil rights legislation that prohibits discrimination in different settings including: employment, education, voting and public accommodations.

Section 201.(a) is particularly applicable for discrimination against unlawful covid-19 mandates (ie wearing a mask and forced vaccines in violation of religious beliefs).

TITLE II -- INJUNCTIVE RELIEF AGAINST DISCRIMINATION IN PLACES OF PUBLIC ACCOMMODATION

SEC. 201. (a) All persons shall be entitled to the full and equal enjoyment of the goods, services, facilities, and privileges, advantages, and accommodations of any place of public accommodation, as defined in this section, without discrimination or segregation on the ground of race, color, religion, or national origin.
